## Military, school leaders meet to discuss Sigsbee Elementary

Key West's military leaders met with local school officials Wednesday, Sept. 1 to discuss Sigsbee Elementary School and the future of the school at its site on Sigsbee Park.

"There has been a lot of con-

cern and discussion regarding the status of Sigsbee Elementary as the Monroe County School District moves forward with plans to rebuild and renovate schools in Key West," said Capt. James Scholl, commanding officer of NAS Key West.

The Sept. 1 meeting was prompted by Monroe County School Superintendent John Padgett after a public forum meeting of military families held Aug. 23 at Sigsbee Elementary. Many military families were surprised and concerned to learn that one of the options being considered in the school district's construction plans included closing the school and consolidat-

ing the 229-member student body with a new, larger Poinciana Elementary School.

"Another option would be to renovate or replace the existing small Sigsbee School but with a shortage of funds it is unclear when that could happen," added Padgett.

Superintendent Padgett told the group that funding and operational costs had to be considered when looking at all the options. A number of schools within the district are in need of replacement or major renovation, due to age and wear. The board faces having to maintain four schools within the city of Key West, when three schools could more efficiently

service the existing elementary-age population.

The meeting Wednesday included Superintendent John Padgett, Deputy Superintendent of Business and Administration Dr. Mary Chambers, Scholl, Lt. Cmdr. Tyonia Burns and CMDCM (SW) Kraig Holubar, command master chief, both of NAS Key West, Commanding Officer Capt. Phil Heyl and Executive Officer Cmdr. Jim Fitton, both of Coast Guard Sector 4 Key West, and Army Col. Steve Sheehan, Chief of Staff, and David Evans, command master chief, both of Joint Interagency Task Force South.

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

does exactly that. Work place culture is changed through the identification of hazards and dangers associated with the step-by-step processes of our jobs. You've already practiced the Integrated Management System if your morning drive changed because school started again and buses are back on the roads.

There is one other thing I hope keeps changing. The next time you drive onto the air station, take a note of the sign indicating the number of consecutive days since the last lost man-day due to an injury. My hope is that we can reach 100 consecutive days without a lost

day of work because of an injury. The Labor Day weekend gives us one last summer break but it's also a time we need to be on alert for safety hazards.

There will be more people on the road and Hurricane Frances is lurking off the Florida coast. A long weekend, holiday travelers, and threatening weather are potentials for an accident. Travel defensively.

Wear seatbelts in the car or a helmet and proper clothing if you're on a motorcycle. Reaching a goal like 100 days without a safety mishap isn't just something to brag about. A milestone like that that tells me we're thinking safety and we're changing our safety culture.

## Key West flag football preseason excitement

Leading the preseason championship game on Monday night 12-0, NAS Key West's Security Department was ready to cuff and stuff another victim with its tenacious defense and hot-pursuit offense. However, Security should've remembered something Baltimore Ravens linebacker Ray Lewis said to quarterback Elvis Grbac during

Super Bowl XXXV, "You don't have to win it, just don't lose it." Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Detachment (AIMD) almost got away with a stolen prize but Security locked up the pre-season tournament in the end by a slim one-point win, 13-12.

"I thought we were going to win on the last charge," said AIMD officer-in-charge Lieutenant Ken Thompson. With little more than a few minutes left to play, AIMD intercepted a pass from Security Department's quarterback Aviation Boatswain's Mate Handler 2nd Class David Morton and scored a quick six points. AIMD was denied the extra point when a wide-open receiver caught the potential point-tying reception beyond the end zone. A few plays later, Security's Morton was intercepted again while trying to scramble deep in his team's territory. AIMD had time and field posi-

tion. The one thing they didn't have enough of was offense.

"They tried to shake us up on their final possession," said Security Department team captain Master at Arms 1st Class Reico Taylor. "We were getting good pressure on their quarterback so they replaced quarterback Chief Aviation Structural Mechanic Rob Kimble with Aviation Ordnanceman 3rd

Class William Chambers." Running from different formations, AIMD managed to move the ball inside the Security Department's 20-yard line but their drive shut down after a key "sack" of the AIMD quarterback by Security's Aviation Ordnanceman 3rd Class Arthur Williams on third down. AIMD turned the ball over after a fourth down pass

attempt fell incomplete.

"It wasn't pretty but it was a win," Taylor conceded. "Our defense made adjustments and held tough."

Security Department, with pre-season tournament laurels, entered the regular intramural flag football season Wednesday night against eight other teams, including AIMD, who will certainly be looking for payback.

## Anger - don't let it get the better of you

We all get angry. We all lost our temper from time to time. We all sometimes lose control. For most of us, however, when we get angry we have methods to deal with the anger — methods that allow us to control our anger before it gets the better of us. Few of us lash out physically or verbally harm someone else. So what about you? Do you ever let anger get the better of you?

The definition of anger includes words like fury, rage and indignation. In essence, anger is an intense emotional state induced by displeasure. I don't think there's anything too surprising in the definition. What's surprising to me, however, is how some Sailors seem to take anger too far.

Each day I read message traffic and am disappointed every time I read about a Sailor who became angry and harmed

someone, whether it was another Sailor, his or her children, or a friend or family member. As we go through our lives and careers, many things provide us displeasure, but we must develop rational ways to cope — before we do things that can cost us personally or professionally.

The difficulty lies in anger itself. Anger is a natural defense we all have. It's an adaptive

response to threats, and sometimes inspires aggressive feelings and behaviors, which allow us to defend ourselves when we are attacked. A certain amount of anger, then, is present in all of us. On the other hand, we can't lash out at everyone who makes us angry for one reason or other because there are laws, customs and social norms that seek to restrict that type of aggressive behavior.

Think back to the last time

you were angry. What made you angry? Was it something that you could change? Did you let something or someone get to you more than you should have? Did you overreact because you were under stress? No matter what the cause, there are some commonly accepted ways to manage anger.

For starters, if you feel yourself becoming angry, sometimes it's wise to step back and take a breath. Distance yourself from the source of your anger for a moment or two and really think about your situation. Many times people realize their anger was disproportionate to the situation.

Next, you have to admit, even if only to yourself, that you were angry. Denial just makes the internal fire burn hotter. If you don't express yourself or find a way to let the anger out, it will no doubt build up. Everyone has a breaking point — a point that should be avoided at almost all cost — but if you never deal with your anger, eventually even little things start to trigger intense reactions.

Finally, there are things you can do to prevent anger. Most agree exercise reduces stress and improves mental sharpness.

I'm not doctor, but I know for a fact I feel better when I work out. I also think I'm more able to deal with stress and unforeseen circumstances that, had I not worked out, might have upset me. We all have levels of stress. If going to the gym for an hour, or going for a run, can somehow allow us all to take stress more in stride, I can't help but think it's a good thing.

Shipmates, when we lose control we lose more than a momentary loss of perspective. Often, we can lose other very important things as well — like credibility and respect.

Think about it. How many people do you know that you would describe as angry. Do you turn to them for advice? Do you look for ways to work with them or do you go to great lengths to avoid them? What about you? How do you think others view you? Perhaps some self reflection is good from time to time to think about how we act, especially since we all know others are not only watching us, they are also judging us.

Clearly we cannot eliminate all the things in our lives that frustrate us. We can't make annoying people go away. We


can't alter the course of events that sometimes leave us angry. However, we can take rational steps to ensure that we have the necessary mental awareness to handle things that could, if we had no internal defense, lead to rage or physical altercation.

As a parting thought, as always, I would offer that sometimes anger has a way of consuming us. If people or events in your life have made you so angry that you no longer seem to have rational ways to cope, please seek help.

Trust me, there is no shame in asking for help, or at least not compared to the shame you may feel if you hit a loved one, attack a Shipmate, or lose control and suffer career damage. Good luck and see you about the fleet!

"We wanted to get a clear understanding of the district's issues and to ensure the district understood our issues," Scholl said. "We also wanted to be able to work with the Superintendent and school system in discussing a plan that would benefit the military families as well as the community."

Everyone agreed retaining Sigsbee Elementary School is an important quality of life issue for military families in the Key West community. The unique nature of

being a military family member makes the neighborhood school an anchor for growth and learning for young students who often find themselves moving to a new school every two or three years.

Among the ideas discussed was whether a new larger elementary school could be built at Sigsbee housing area and consolidate the students from Poinciana. The Poinciana site could then be used for teacher housing or additional recreational fields. Chambers and Burns also discussed the difficulties in finding federal and state funds to support the school and

maintain the status quo. They plan to continue their efforts in that search for funding.

"The idea of closing Sigsbee Elementary and consolidating with another school isn't new," said Burns, Education Liaison Officer for NAS Key West. "School officials proposed closing Sigsbee as far back as 2002."

The property, approximately 11 acres, was conveyed to the school district in 1958 for the purpose of education, according to Ron Demes, Business Manager of NAS Key West. Even if the school is closed and razed, the school district will own the property.

"Good communications and teamwork are the backbone of successfully educating all students," said Scholl. "It takes community involvement to provide the best schools for our students. This lunch certainly broadened the lines of communications between the military and Monroe County school officials. We understand the county's needs and they understand ours. Together, with other families in Key West, federal, state and local elected officials, we are hopeful we can find a viable solution."

Padget assured the group that

when the school board makes a decision, it would be done at a meeting in Key West. He did say he also supported further discussion on the issue. A meeting has been set for Sept. 8 at the Harvey Government Center; the time had not been set as of press time.

## Sailor to compete at Athens Paralympics

WASHINGTON (NNS) — Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class Casey Tibbs is heading to Athens next week, looking for gold in the 400-meter, 4x400-meter relay and the pentathlon track and field events.

If you're thinking he's missed the starter's gun, think again. Tibbs, 24, confirmed that he is the first active-duty service member to compete in the Paralympics that will run Sept. 17-28.

A 110- and 300-meter hurdler at Lake Travis High School in Austin, Texas, Tibbs graduated in 1999 and entered the Navy

about a month later. He also quit running competitively.

"I thought I was done (running)," Tibbs said.

A motorcycle accident March 5, 2001, and the events that followed changed his mind. Tibbs lost his right leg below the knee in that accident. Because of the investment in his training, the Navy gave him an option of separating or staying in. He chose to stay.

About a year after being back on active duty, he read an article about Paralympians and was inspired. Tibbs decided he would compete in the next Paralympics.

He said his first track meet went so well that the Paralympics coaches called him and invited him to a national meet. He said he is currently

ranked No. 2 in the world in the 400-meter. He qualified for the 2004 games with a pentathlon score of 4,573 during the 2004 Far West Games held at San Jose City College in California.

Rankings for the pentathlon (long-jump, shot put, discus, 100- and 400-meter events) haven't been released yet, but he said he feels competitive in the event. He will be among about 4,000 athletes from 130 countries to compete.

Tibbs has spent the past week in Oklahoma City, Okla., getting a new prosthesis. He said he's been training on his new leg for the past week and has no anxiety about running on it in his events.

"The thing about the Paralympics is, you can be a great athlete and a good runner,

but you're only going to run as good as your prosthesis is going to allow you to run," Tibbs said.

"I'm really excited. It's been a lot of work," Tibbs said. "Training for it is no fun at all. It's not a fun sport to train for. But it's all worth it once it's over and you get a medal."

If everything goes well in Athens, Tibbs said he'd like to compete in the 2008 Paralympics.

"From everything, it looks like the Navy supports me 100 percent," he said, adding that the Navy Sports Department, headed by John Hickok, has arranged for transportation to meets and provided uniforms. Tibbs said that Hickok also worked with Adidas to secure sponsorship for him. He said his command has been very supportive, as well.

The meaning of being the first active-duty Paralympian is not lost on Tibbs, who is stationed at Naval Security Group Activity Medina in San Antonio.

Tibbs said he never would have expected when he lost his leg that his life wouldn't change drastically. "When you lose your leg, people kind of first assume that 'My life is totally different now. I've got to live differently,'" Tibbs said. "There are little changes, but really for the most part, nothing's really changed for me. Everything has changed for the better for me."

"I wouldn't ever have dreamed of going to the Paralympics... ever," he said. "And now, (I'm about) to go to Greece to compete against everybody else, which is amazing."
