## Navy units assist interdiction of 2 largest drug shipments in history

MAYPORT, Fla. (NNS) — Two U.S. Navy ships, their embarked helicopters and two maritime patrol aircraft supported the two largest drug seizures in history while deployed to the U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command area of responsibility (AOR) in September.

More than 75,000 pounds of cocaine were seized in this interagency effort coordinated through Joint Interagency Task Force South and led by U.S. Coast Guard teams embarked on U.S. Navy frigates USS Curts (FFG 38) and USS Crommelin (FFG 37). The operations were supported by embarked helicopter squadrons from Helicopter Anti-submarine Squadron Light (HSL) 37 and HSL-45, in addition to U.S. Navy P-3 maritime patrol aircraft



patrolling the area.

“The success of these operations can only be credited to the synergy developed between the U.S. Navy, the [U.S] Coast Guard

and other agencies in the AOR,” said Rear Adm. Vinson E. Smith, the commander of all naval assets operating in the U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command area of responsibility. “Our ships and aircraft know the mission and bring their crucial assets to the theater in support of the Coast Guard’s law enforcement role.”

The first seizure happened Sept. 17 when Curts intercepted a suspected fishing vessel approximately 300 miles west of the Galapagos Islands. After boarding the vessel, Curts’ embarked Law Enforcement Detachment (LEDET) 108 discovered more than 30,000 pounds of cocaine hidden in a ship’s compartment. The drugs were seized to be used as evidence against the 10 suspects

Sailors assigned to the guided missile frigate USS Crommelin (FFG 37), stack 525 bales of cocaine seized this week during an interdiction in the Eastern Pacific. Crommelin, working with U.S. Coast Guard Law Enforcement Detachment (LEDET) 105, and embarked Helicopter Anti-Submarine Squadron Light Three Seven (HSL-37), conducted what turns out to be the third largest drug interdiction in history, totaling 25,000 pounds of narcotics. Six days earlier, the guided missile frigate USS Curts (FFG 38) conducted a similar operation interdicting 30,000 pounds of cocaine, the largest drug seizure to date.

## Problems usually don't get better with time

"Bad news doesn't get better with age," is a quote that comes to mind when someone brings me news they don't really want to tell me. If my first question isn't, "Is anyone hurt?" then I'm going to ask, "How long have we known about the problem?"

I usually find out that the problem isn't something new but an issue people hoped would get better in time. Problems don't get better with time. We need to share the bad news with the good. Good communications are an essential element of any successful team.

As the Navy turns to the business world for solutions to day-to-day operations, we can learn something about improving our communications as well. In a recent study, companies who made significant improvements with the ability to communicate with their workers and their customers increased their market value by almost 30 percent.

These same organizations that communicated effectively reported employee turnover rates below or significantly below their industry peers. Regardless of what metric researchers use, effective communications are key drivers for superior performance.

Reporting to a new command is never easy. Every year, approximately one third of NAS Key West personnel are replaced by new personnel as part of the normal rotation process.

Good communications help newcomers feel connected to the command and they quickly come to understand how their

expertise can support and improve operations here.

Good communication also helps the chain of command accomplish all parts of the mission whether on the flight line or in the command building. We have great tools to help us communicate.

Base marquees, websites, e-mail, the *Southernmost Flyer*, and the plan of the week are just some of the tools.

## Marine Corps to add insect repellent to utilities

MARINE CORPS BASE QUANTICO, Va (Sept. 29, 2004) — The Marine Corps is considering a new plan to treat the Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniform at the factory level with permethrin prior to them hitting the shelves for sale or issue.

Permethrin is a man-made insecticide, structurally similar to a naturally occurring chemical called pyrethrum. Pyrethrum was initially derived from the crushed dried flowers of the daisy *Chrysanthemum*, according to the Environmental Protection Agency's Web site.

Permethrin currently is applied at the unit level prior to and during deployment, said Lt. Col. Gabe Patricio, program manager, Infantry Combat Equipment, Marine Corps Systems Command.

Factory treatment of uniforms would make the logistics of protection much easier for units and individual Marines, said Navy Capt. Eric C. McDonald, surgeon with I Marine Expeditionary Force.

There are two methods to apply permethrin in the field, said McDonald.

"The first is individual dynamic application kits; sometimes called the 'shake and bake' kit because an individual can treat one uniform in the kit by placing it in a bag and shaking it up to saturate the uniform, then taking it out to dry," said McDonald.

The other is method is mass spraying by preventive medicine technicians for which large, open, non-windy, dirt free places to spray are required, said McDonald.

"[There are] not many of those in the desert," said McDonald.

"The current field application methods result in a high possibility of untreated or incorrectly treated uniforms," said Patricio.

He added that the requirement to treat uniforms during a deployment also is a burden for the units.

Permethrin works as a contact insecticide, preventing insects from biting through clothing. Permethrin is effective against multiple species of crawling and flying insects, including mosquitoes, ticks, fleas, bedbugs, chiggers and flies.

Uniforms treated with permethrin are probably the most important part of the personal protection system to protect against insect-borne disease, said McDonald. Biting insects can spread several diseases, including leishmaniasis, malaria, West Nile virus, Lyme disease and encephalitis. Permethrin-treat-

## Navy temporarily suspends PCS transfers to Pensacola

WASHINGTON (NNS) — The Chief of Naval Personnel (CNP) has temporarily suspended orders for transferring Sailors scheduled to report to the Naval Air Station (NAS) Pensacola region between Sept. 14 and Oct. 31 due to damage by Hurricane Ivan.

This affects Sailors with orders to NAS Pensacola, NAS Whiting Field, Corry Station, Saufley Field, and all tenant commands and activities aboard these installations as either an ultimate or intermediate duty station.

This decision to suspend orders to the region came after

consultation between CNP, Commander, Naval Education and Training Command, and Commander, Navy Region Gulf Coast. Updates will be made as necessary.

"We want to be mindful of the recovery efforts ongoing, and will work closely with the regional commander and the local commands to ensure our Sailors are taken care of," said Vice Adm. Gerry Hoewing, Chief of Naval Personnel.

Transferring Sailors are strongly encouraged to remain in contact with their detailer for updated information. # Seaman to Admiral 21 board postponed due to hurricane

GREAT LAKES, Ill. (NNS) — The Navy has postponed its previously scheduled Seaman-to-Admiral 21 (STA-21) selection board as a result of the impact of Hurricane Ivan aboard Naval Air Station Pensacola and surrounding facilities.

A NAVADMIN released by Vice Adm. A.G. Harms Jr., Director of Naval Education and Training, stressed that STA-21 applications and records are intact. There is no need to resubmit applications, and new applications will not be accepted.

Dr. C.J. Stein directs the STA-21 program and said the program is continuing to get back up to speed.

"By next week, we should be back up to full operations," she said. "We hope to continue board deliberations next week."

The board results are expected to be published no later than the end of November.

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# Second 'Wild Bird' rescue in two weeks

## *Of helmets and herons*

A great white heron had a close call with death last weekend at the Truman Navy Base on Fleming Key. The heron was spotted Monday in the mangroves entangled in monofilament fish line with a blue hard hat attached. It was emaciated and near death when the base called Wild Bird Rescue of Big Pine. Director Maya Totman responded immediately.

With the help of Security patrolman MA2 Jimmy Williams, Maya rescued the heron, cleared it of the fish line and hardhat, and took it to the Center's care facility on Big Pine for rehabilitation. Prospects for full recovery are good, thanks to the fast response of base personnel.

This is the second bird rescue in a week from the same area.

"Discarded trash and litter are major causes of wildlife disablement and death, especially wild birds," warns Totman.

She asks for help from all Keys citizens in cleaning up roadside and backyard trash. Totman notes that monofilament fishing line is particularly life threatening because hundreds, if not thousands, of seabirds get tangled up in it each year in the Keys. It is near-

ly invisible to the birds and too tough for them to remove once entangled. Once immobilized they cannot feed or drink and

will die of starvation and flesh wounds.

Fishermen should dispose of used monofilament carefully, using the many roadside disposal containers placed along U.S. 1 at many of the bridges or put it safely in trash containers.

Islands, Crommelin set a course to intercept, and once in range, sent its SH-60B Seahawk to relocate and monitor the vessel as Crommelin moved into a position to strike. At the appropriate time, embarked LEDET 105 conducted a swift take down of the suspect vessel, supported by Crommelin's rigid hull inflatable boat. By sundown Sept. 24, LEDET and Crommelin's crew had recovered a total of 525

bales of cocaine and taken eight suspects into custody.

Curts, homeported in San Diego, and Crommelin, homeported in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, are conducting a six-month deployment to the U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command area of responsibility. Since reporting on station in the Eastern Pacific May 20, Crommelin has disrupted four narcotics smuggling operations, interdicted nearly \$1 billion worth of cocaine and detained 32 suspected narcotics smugglers.

This is Curts' second inter-
