### 1. Date and Location

a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as president and the members listed in enclosure (1), is ordered to convene at Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 0800, 23 July 2013, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-14 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).

### 2. Function

a. The function of the board is to recommend officers on the Active-Duty List of the Navy in the Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAGC) for command. Selection by this board does not create a right or obligation to detail an officer selected to a command billet.

b. The board will have available for review each candidate's Official Military Personnel File, any board correspondence submitted by the candidate, and any information provided by the candidate's Oral Board in accordance with the Oral Board's Precept.

3. Board Authorized Selections. The total number of candidates that may be recommended in each competitive category is all fully qualified.

4. **Additional Guidance.** The below information is provided to clarify community requirements and any specific needs, but in no way should replace the Best and Fully Qualified Standard of reference (a).

a. Because the board is authorized to recommend all fully qualified officers, the "best qualified" standard in paragraph 4b of reference (a) does not apply.

b. The board shall evaluate the applicant's maturity, character, temperament, judgment, motivation for command, and familiarity with JAGC and Naval Legal Service Command programs and policies.

c. Developing the lawyers, Legalmen, and civilian employees capable of supporting the Navy's mission whenever and wherever needed requires assigning the very best officers to command. A commanding officer (CO) must be a person of unfailing integrity, with exceptional judgment, who has performed superbly in positions of increased responsibility throughout the JAGC and the Navy.

d. Superior performance while serving in leadership positions, such as Department Head, Officer in Charge, Executive Officer, OJAG Division Director, and senior Staff Judge Advocate, including acting assignments, can demonstrate potential for command.

e. COs are expected to emphasize and facilitate the training of JAGC personnel in the provision of quality legal services and professional development. Demonstrated success with implementing, executing, and monitoring training and mentoring programs can demonstrate potential for command.

f. Many CO positions within the JAGC are at commands in the Naval Legal Service Command that provide legal assistance, command services, and military justice advice and support. Superior performance in these areas, such as designation as a Military Justice Litigation specialist or expert, can indicate potential for command. However, less experience in these areas does not preclude command.

g. Naval Legal Service Command provides legal services to shore commands and the Fleet. Demonstrated superior performance in providing legal services to Fleet or shore commands can demonstrate potential for command.

h. In this age of limited resources and fiscal constraints, Navy leaders must demonstrate judiciousness in fiscal resources, personnel, facility management, energy resource management and technology, all of which are of vital importance to our Navy today and in the future. Demonstrated past judiciousness in these areas can therefore be an indication of potential for command.
