1. Vehicles that have the steering wheel on the right side CANNOT be imported.
2. Vehicles which are more than 8 years of manufactured can be imported into El Salvador under Duty Free Status, but they CANNOT be sold in Country.
3. Only one vehicle is authorized to be imported under Duty Free Basis.
4. Your vehicle is authorized to arrive in El Salvador **ONLY** after your arrival at Post.
5. The Title must show your name as the owner of the vehicle.

2. Copy of Invoice or Bill of Sale.

Upon your arrival at San Salvador, you must provide, to the Shipping and Customs Section, the ORIGINAL TITLE OF OWNERSHIP, as well as copy of the invoice or Bill of Sale, showing the price of the vehicle.

If the car is being financed, (i.e. you have a loan), you must provide the following documents as well, upon your arrival at post:

1. Invoice or Bill of Sale.
2. An original notarized copy of the title of ownership.
3. Original Letter from the Bank stating that the original title is being held by them.

If you drive to El Salvador, please inform to Shipping and Customs Section and make sure you obtain a sixty day permit at the Salvadoran border, which is required to complete the importation process.
