LTC Matthew Jury was assigned as Deputy Director, Joint Tactical Networking Center (JTNC) in April 2016. Previously, LTC Jury was assigned as the Product Manager for the Joint Enterprise Network Manager in PEO-C3T from 2014-2016. In his current role, he is responsible for providing oversight and management in the execution of tactical and strategic plans for the JTNC.

LTC Jury graduated from the United States Military Academy and was commissioned as an Aviation Officer in May 1993. His first duty assignment after the Army Aviation Flight School at Fort Rucker, Alabama, was in the 3d Armored Cavalry Regiment (ACR), Fort Bliss, Texas from March 1994 until August 1995, as an Aeroscout Platoon Leader. He then changed duty stations with the 3d ACR, as they moved to Fort Carson, Colorado. There, he served as the 4th Squadron Flight Operations Officer, followed by the Fort Carson Installation Aviation Officer until November 1997.

In December 1998, LTC Jury was assigned to the 25th Infantry Division at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, where he served as the 25th Aviation Intermediate Maintenance Company Direct Support Platoon Leader, and Troop Commander for 3d Squadron, 4th Cavalry Division, where he deployed to multiple Joint Drug Interdiction Missions. In March 2001, he assumed duties as the Shops Platoon Leader for the 25th Aviation Intermediate Maintenance Company.

In January 2002, LTC Jury assessed into the Army Acquisition Corps and was assigned to the Force Transformation Directorate of TRADOC at Fort Monroe. In February 2003, LTC Jury was selected as the Aide-de-Camp and Executive Officer for the Deputy Director of the Army's Future's Center at TRADOC. In March 2004, he was assigned as the deployment team lead for the TRADOC Spiral Developments Division and deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom to emplace survivability equipment for numerous FOBs, while participating in numerous combat aviation missions. Upon redeployment, he served as the Assistant TRADOC Systems Manager for the ARH Helicopter at Fort Rucker, Alabama from June 2005 until June 2007.

In July 2007, LTC Jury returned to Virginia to assume duties as the Assistant Program Manager for the MH-47 Heavy Assault Fleet at Fort Eustis, Virginia with the Technology Applications Program Office (TAPO). While there, he deployed again with the 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan. In July 2009, he began studies at the Florida Institute of Technology, earning a Master's Degree in Acquisition Management. Upon completion, he was assigned briefly to ACD, TRADOC as the Executive Officer, before being selected as the Product Manager for the MH-47 Special Operations Aviation (SOA) Heavy Assault Helicopter in August 2011. Upon completing his duties with the MH-47 PM Office, LTC Jury was selected as the Product Manager for the Joint Enterprise Network Manager in 2014.

LTC Jury's military education includes Acquisition Corps Level III Certification (2012); PMT Program Managers Course (2012); Command and General Staff College (2007); Material Acquisition Management School (2002); Combined Arms Services Staff School (1998); Aviation Maintenance Managers Course (1998); Aviation Officer Advance Course (1997); Army Aviation Flight School (1993); Aviation Officer Basic Course (1993); US Army Air Assault School (1991); US Army Airborne School (1990). His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal (silver OLC), Army Commendation Medal (3 OLC), Army Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal (1 Bronze Service Star), GWOT-Expeditionary Medal, GWOT-Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Ribbon, the Presidential Unit and Army Superior Unit Awards, the Combat Action Badge (Iraq), the Army Parachutist Badge, Army Air Assault Badge, and Army Senior Aviator Badge.
